While services under the prior contract were suspended due to funding limitations, Picture of Health has retained the clinical capacity and operational infrastructure necessary to promptly resume services upon contract award. The company also anticipates adding at least one additional physician during the upcoming contract period.

Picture of Health has direct experience supporting Disability Determination Services through both Mississippi DDS and Delaware DDS. Services provided include review of medical evidence, assessment of impairment severity, completion of disability determination evaluations, recommendations for additional development, review and signing of determinations, and compliance with SSA quality requirements.

The company utilizes licensed physicians with extensive clinical and disability evaluation experience and maintains the administrative infrastructure necessary to support timely, accurate, and compliant case review services.
